

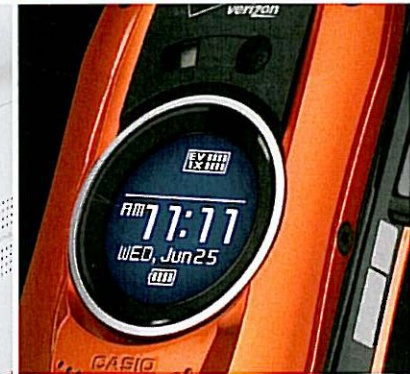

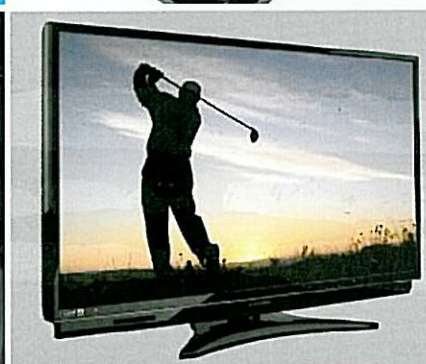

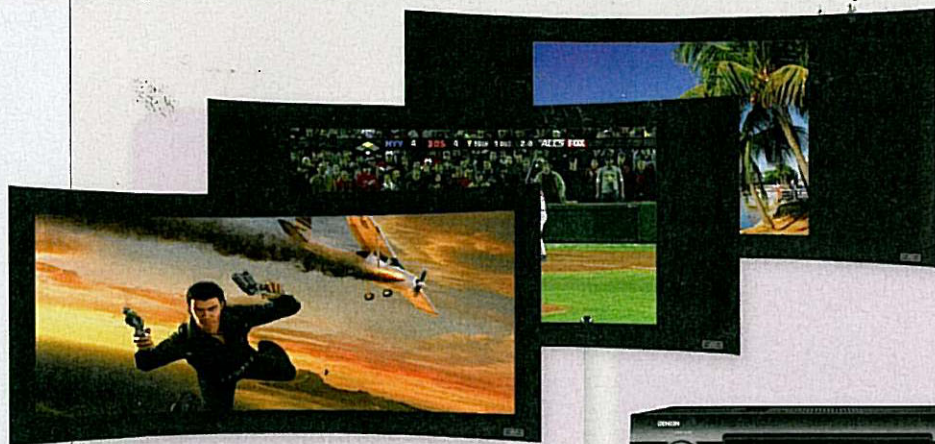

A true home theater screen, the Vision X Dyna-Curve has a curved design and a 2.35:1 aspect ratio, ideal for mating with a projector that uses an anamorphic lens attachment. The Dyna-Curve series is available in a fixed shape or with an automated masking system that supports multiple aspect ratios. The screen comes in a variety of surfaces, including Vutec's new high-gain, high-contrast SilverStar.

Part of Denon's direct-to-consumer line, the 7.1-channel AVR-990 sports a number of features offered in Denon's higher-end specialty-market receivers—including a newly designed onscreen menu, Dolby Pro Logic IIz, Audyssey's advanced suite, HD Radio, and an Ethernet port for Web-based control, Web browsing, and audio streaming from Rhapsody and Napster. This receiver uses Anchor Bay's ABT-2010 video processing chip to upconvert all sources to 1080p.

**Runco LightStyle Series Projectors****\$4,995 - LS-3****\$6,995 - LS-5****\$15,495 - LS-7**www.runco.com

Runco's LightStyle Series, the LS-3, LS-5 and LS-7, combines state-of-the-art DLP-based SuperOnyx technology with Runco ConstantContrast and Vivix image enhancement and proprietary video processing to achieve deep black levels and significant contrast, each measuring above 10,000:1. All projectors in this series also feature the ISF calibration suite. The three-chip LS-7 offers six lens options while the 1080p LS-3 and LS-5 offer two lens options. The LS-3 and LS-5 will be available in November for \$4,995 and \$6,995, respectively, and the LS-7 will be available in early December for an MSRP of \$15,495.

**Marantz NR1501 A/V Receiver****\$599.99**www.marantz.com

The Marantz NR1501 sports a "Slimline" design (just over 4" high, 13" deep) and is also a 7-channel amplifier that can fit just about anywhere. It includes four HDMI Version 1.3 inputs, built-in upscaler with all built-in audio codecs, including decoding for Dolby TruHD and DTS Master Audio and more. The NR1501 makes it easy to get the best high definition sound to your ears with an automatic calibration process that identifies your system's speaker complement, measures the distances between your speakers and your favorite viewing/listening position for the most accurate delay settings and adjusts relative speaker levels for the most natural surround effects.

**Digeo Moxi High Definition Digital Video Recorder****\$799 (You can also pay in four monthly payments of \$199.75 or 20 monthly payments of \$39.95.)**www.digeo.com

The Moxi system was designed from the beginning to take full advantage of wide-screen HDTVs and its 500GB hard drive can hold up to 75 hours of recordings at full 1080 resolution. Some features of the Moxi DVR include dual-tuner HD DVR that allows users to record two shows and watch a third pre-recorded show all in HD; users can play, pause and rewind live TV. It also brings Web-based services such as Flickr, Finetune and more to the HDTV and is Dolby Digital certified for high-fidelity surround sound. The Moxi DVR gives users access to a variety of Internet content including news, sports scores, entertainment and financial information, weather and more through MoxiNet and the Moxi SuperTicker.
